We would like to invite you to participate in this event, co-sponsored by the Yorke Peninsula Council, ACS, Coast Protection Board, Northern and Yorke Landscape Board, and the Beach and Dune Systems (BEADS) Laboratory at Flinders University.

The Forum theme is *Building a Sustainable Coastal Future*.
