

Professor Bruce Mitchell



Professor Bruce Mitchell is the most recent ANZSOG-Goyder Institute Visiting Professor with his term ending in early May 2014.

He joined us from the University of Waterloo, Ontario, Canada where he is Professor of Geography and Environmental Management, cross appointed in the School of Planning, and Associate Provost, Academic and Student Affairs.

His research specialization is the governance and policy aspects of water management, plus integrated resource and environmental management.

Professor Mitchell has studied water management for over 42 years, with particular attention to integrated management. He has written/edited 27 books and more than 145 articles. He also is General Editor of the "Themes in Resource Management" Series of Longman Scientific and Technical, London, in which 11 books have been published.

Previously, he was the Academic Co-Director of the Bali Sustainable Development Project in Indonesia, and was a team member responsible for analysis of institutional arrangements for a project focused on land and water management in Sokoto State in northwestern Nigeria. He was one team member in a collaborative environmental research program with the University of Madras in India. He also has conducted research in China and Australia. He was the Co-Director (Programs) for a University Consortium on the Environment project in Sulawesi, Indonesia, focused upon environmental impact assessment and ecosystem-based research.
